People in Logie Manor Croft



Manor Croft was built in 1946/47 by Duncan McInnes Moorhead, an architect, who is listed as both the owner and occupier until 1950, when he sold the property to Mr. Alfred Hansen (listed in the Council records as a baker) and his wife Agnes H. Hansen. They lived in Manor Croft until 1979 where they brought up their children Lys and Louis.

Louis Hansen married Joan Kenton from Harrogate in 1978 and lived in Blackpool prior to his death in ??? Lys Hansen married George Sutherland in 1962 and, after first having moved to London, came back to Blairlogie and Manor Croft, with their son Giles who was born in 1963. In 1967, they moved into Blairlogie Cottage, where their second son Marcus was born in 1969 Alfred and Agnes celebrated their silver wedding at the Allan Water Hotel in 1956, and, eventually, both died in the same year of 1990, but not before moving on to end their days with their daughter Lys and her husband George Sutherland at their home in Blairlogie Cottage.
